Post the resources boom, shopping centre development is set to be a key driver of employment growth in Perth's property and construction markets till the end of the decade. Shopping centre owners, confident in the long term outlook for the State, are set to invest an estimated \$5.1 billion dollars between 2016 and the end of the decade in the development of new neighbourhood centres and the expansion of existing centres. This investment is set to create over 50,000 jobs in the construction and operation of these centres.

Y Research's May 2017 Metropolitan Perth Shopping Centre Development Report details the current status of developments in shopping centres across the Perth metropolitan region from Alkimos in

the north to Austin Lakes in the south. This Report provides independent analysis of 49 shopping centre developments across metropolitan Perth that were completed in 2016, or are either under construction or are actively progressing through the development approval process.
